COVID-19 Policy

This policy applies to all individuals (hereinafter referred to as Participant or Participants) participating at events (hereinafter referred to as Event or Events) affiliated with the Saskatchewan Badminton Association (hereinafter referred to as SBA). Events include but not limited to tournaments, tryouts, and meetings. Participants include athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators.

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization and COVID-19 is extremely contagious. The SBA has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, the SBA cannot guarantee that the Participants will not become infected with COVID-19. Participants are responsible for choosing the Participants' safety or protective equipment and the secure fitting of that equipment.

All Participants must be "fully vaccinated" to participate in any Event. "Fully vaccinated" means 14 days after receiving:

- the second of two doses of an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer, Moderna) or AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD (all interchangeable between the two doses), or
- 1 dose of Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) vaccine.

Participants are required to show proof of vaccination upon request by Event organizers. Options for showing proof of vaccination include:

- QR code/MySaskHealthRecord vaccine certificate uploaded to SK Vax Wallet or another wallet app, or
- A copy of your MySaskHealthRecord vaccine certificate with QR code, or
- A screenshot of your MySaskHealthRecord vaccine certificate/QR code saved to your device, or
- The wallet card or earlier version of the MySaskHealthRecord COVID-19 vaccine certificate, or
- A COVID-19 vaccine printout from Saskatchewan Health Authority Public Health

Participants from outside of Saskatchewan must show proof of vaccination provided by their location of residency.

Participants aged 18 and older must also show photo identification along with the proof of vaccination. Participants aged 12 to 17 must also show identification unless accompanied by an adult with proof of vaccination and identification. Acceptable forms of identification include driver's license and passport. Participants aged 12 to 17 not accompanied by an adult and do not have photo identification, must present another form of government identification such as birth certificate or health services card.

The SBA retains the right to refuse any individual who does not meet the above-mentioned criteria from participating in the Events.
